Police seek resident of house that burned

SYKESVILLE - Pennsylvania State Police are seeking the public's help in locating a resident whose

home was severely damaged in an early-Thursday morning fire in Sykesville. According to DuBois-base Pennsylvania State Police, the fire marshal is investigating the fire, which occurred at 90 Fugate Drive in Sykesville.

Police said the fire consumed a large portion of the residence.

Out of concern for her welfare, police seek to locate Joey Lynn Offutt, 33.

She is described as a white female, 5-feet, 3-inches tall, thin build, with brown hair and eyes, police said.

Police said she may be operating a red 1994 Saturn coupe with Virginia registration JXN8871.

Police said the vehicle reportedly has very visible damage to the front part of its hood.

According to reports, the fire broke out shortly after 4 a.m. Wednesday morning, where fire units from Sykesville, Reynoldsville, Punxsutawney, DuBois and Sandy Township responded.

Further information about the fire was unavailable.
